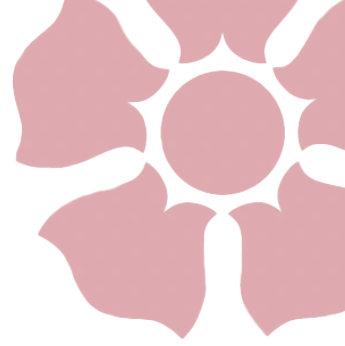




The 1919 *Society*
